SENATE CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION 80

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for office space; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the board of county commissioners in each county in the State of Oklahoma to furnish quarters for the local units of the Department of Human Services, unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Board of County Commissioners of Beaver and Cimarron Counties, Oklahoma, does not have adequate resources to meet its legal obligation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services has determined that it is desirable to enter into a project to construct, acquire, and/or renovate an office building to house the staff of the Department of Human Services' Beaver and Cimarron County offices and to lease-purchase the office building; and

WHEREAS, the lease-purchase agreement will provide that, upon conclusion of the lease-purchase term, the title will transfer to the Department of Human Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires that this type of transaction receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services in Beaver and Cimarron Counties, the Commission for Human Services, subject to the availability of funds, is hereby authorized to enter into lease-purchase agreements to construct, acquire or renovate adequate or suitable quarters, office space or facilities needed by the Department of Human Services in Beaver and Cimarron Counties.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services.
