AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution recognizing the Jenks High School Trojans as the 2001 Class 6A State Football Champions; congratulating the football team and coaching staff; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Jenks High School Trojans became the Class 6A State Football Champions for the sixth consecutive year; and

WHEREAS, about 18,000 fans watched Jenks High School defeat Putnam City North by a score of 38-28 at Lewis Stadium in Stillwater, Oklahoma, giving Jenks 38 straight wins, an Oklahoma record for Class 6A high schools; and

WHEREAS, Coach Allan Trimble has compiled a 79-4 record in his six-year career at Jenks, including a 24-0 record in playoff games.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
