AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Hominy Bucks for winning the 2001 Class A football state championship; congratulating Head Coach Danny Daniels upon his selection as "Coach of the Year"; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, over 4,000 enthusiastic fans were at Lewis Field in Stillwater, Oklahoma, to witness the Hominy Bucks win the 2001 Class A football state championship. The Bucks narrowly defeated the Velma-Alma Comets in a tight 3-0 victory, the lowest scoring 11-man championship playoff game since 1944; and

WHEREAS, the Hominy team also won the championship in 1973, 1982 and 1983. Claiming a 14-1 record, this is the first time in 80 years that the Hominy football team has won 14 games in a single season; and

WHEREAS, this is the first state championship for Danny Daniels as head coach of the Hominy Bucks. He was an assistant coach for the other three victories. Coach Daniels has a record of 146-55-0 as head coach of the Bucks; and

WHEREAS, Danny Daniels was selected as "Coach of the Year" by the Bartlesville Examiner-Enterprise, which also selected Hominy player Drew Crawford as the Most Valuable Player and a number of other Bucks to its All-Area Football Team.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Hominy Bucks for winning the 2001 Class A football state championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates Head Coach Danny Daniels upon his selection as "Coach of the Year".
