AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution welcoming the Edmond North High School Huskies Boys Tennis Team to the Oklahoma State Capitol; congratulating them for winning the Class 5-A championship; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, after narrowly losing the state championship in 1998 and 1999, last year, the Edmond North Boys Tennis Team broke Jenks' ten-year streak of winning the state Class 5-A tennis titles; and

WHEREAS, this year the Edmond North Huskies repeated as Class 5-A state champions, edging Jenks 28-27. The Huskies victory was particularly impressive as it had an all-underclassman lineup that faced the Jenks Trojans roster which included five seniors; and

WHEREAS, Coach Mike McLaughlin, who was selected Coach of the Year for the third time, is the only tennis coach Edmond North High School has ever had; and

WHEREAS, the Edmond North High School Huskies Boys Tennis Team won 17 straight tournaments, including the Class 5-A state championship during which they won both singles championships and placed third and fifth in doubles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 48TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate welcomes the Edmond North High School Huskies Boys Tennis Team and coaching staff to the Oklahoma State Capitol.
