WHEREAS, as members of the Oklahoma State University basketball squad, Nate Fleming of Edmond, Oklahoma, and Daniel Lawson of Detroit, Michigan, were an inspiration to their teammates, friends and family, always quick with a smile or a helping hand, both on and off the court; and

WHEREAS, media relations coordinator Will Hancock and basketball operations director Pat Noyes were the wheels that kept the basketball team on track, exhibiting enthusiasm, professionalism and upbeat attitude in all that they did; and

WHEREAS, athletic trainer Brian Luinstra and student assistant Jared Weiberg were integral parts of the Cowboy program, making sure that players and coaches were the best they could possibly be; and

WHEREAS, Kendell Durfey worked diligently behind the scenes to make sure that thousands of Oklahoma State University fans could follow the performance of their beloved Cowboys, often cheering along with them as an ardent supporter of the university's athletic programs; and

WHEREAS, play-by-play commentator Bill Teegins, the beloved voice of the Cowboys, was so much more than an announcer, inspiring fans with his tireless dedication, boundless enthusiasm and inspired call of the game; and

WHEREAS, pilots Bjorn Fahlstrom and Denver Mills were avid basketball fans and true professionals in the air and on the ground; and

WHEREAS, although each of these individuals was taken from life far too soon and will be missed greatly by family and friends, their passion for the game of basketball and life itself will serve as a living legacy that will inspire generations to come.
