This is to advise you that on this date, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution to approve or object to legislation presented to me, I have VETOED House Bill **2608**. This bill requires the Employee Benefits Council and the Oklahoma State Education and Employees Group Insurance Board to offer any licensed vision plan with statewide network to state employees without competitively bidding those services or specifying requirements beyond licensure.

This bill undermines the current legal and fiduciary responsibilities of EBC and OSEEGIB to design, evaluate and select benefit plans through a competitive bidding process.
