ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1400

An Act relating to juveniles; amending Section 1, Chapter 110, O.S.L. 2003 (19 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 339.6), which relates to establishing curfews for juveniles; requiring certain compliance with state and federal laws; modifying penalty; removing jail term; and declaring an emergency.

- AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 1, lines 7 and 8, restore the stricken language "guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a minimum fine of" and delete the language "fined an amount not exceeding"
- and on lines 10 and 11, restore the stricken language "guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine of up to" and delete the language "fined an amount not exceeding"
- and amend title to conform
- AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, Section 1, lines 11 through 15,
- on lines 11 and 12, restore the stricken language "or by imprisonment in the"
- and on line 12, after the stricken word "jail" insert the words "juvenile facility"
- and on lines 12 through 14, restore the stricken language "for a term of not less than one (1) day, nor more than thirty (30) days, or by both fine and imprisonment"
- and on lines 14 and 15, delete the language ", or assigned not more than thirty (30) hours of community service, or both such fine and community service hours"
- and amend title to conform
- AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 15 1/2, insert a new subsection F to read

"F. If persons convicted under this section fail to comply with subsection E of this section, they shall be held in contempt of court and subject to further penalties as ministered by the court."

and amend title to conform
