An Act relating to public health and safety; defining terms; providing for vaccination program for first responders who may be exposed to infectious diseases deployed to disaster locations; making program voluntary; providing exceptions; providing for priority; providing for notification; authorizing certain contracts making section effective upon receipt of certain funds; repealing 63 O.S. 2001, Section 689, which relates to a short title; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, line 8, after the first comma and before the second word "hepatitis" delete all language

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 9, after the second word "vaccination" delete all language before the word "and" on line 10

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 3, line 8, after the period insert the following language

"If federal funds for these vaccines cease, the state shall not be liable for the continuation or cost of vaccines."

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 1, strike the title to read

"[public health and safety - vaccination program -
first responders - codification -
emergency]"
