AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the stricken title, enacting
clause and entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to education; making appropriations
to the State Board of Education; stating purposes;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2004, the sum of One Billion Fifty-one Million One
Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-five Dollars
(\$1,051,110,975.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
financial support of public schools.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 41.29b of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of Four Hundred Forty-eight Million One Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-two Dollars (\$448,176,852.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$1,330,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 4. The State Board of Education is hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, from the Common Education Technology Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Twenty-four Million Six Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$24,661,475.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-five Million Five Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Eighty-three Dollars (\$425,596,083.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Education by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
