AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, line 23, after the period insert
the language

"Except that, this state, any of its agencies, or any court of
this state shall not recognize an adoption by more than one
individual of the same sex from any other state or foreign
jurisdiction."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 3, line 20 1/2, insert a new Section 2
to read

"SECTION 2. If any provision of this act or its application to
any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity does not
affect other provisions or applications of this act which can be
given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to
this end the provisions of this act are severable."

and renumber subsequent sections

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, restore the title to read

"An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,
Section 7502-1.4, which relates to foreign adoptions;
providing exception to recognition to be afforded to
foreign judgments; providing for registration of a
foreign adoption decree, judgment, or order; allowing
combined petitions; requiring certain orders;
modifying application of adoption process for certain
minors born outside the United States; providing for
severability; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency."
