An Act relating to the firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.24, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 465, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1289.24), which relates to state preemption of firearm regulation; adding exception to state preemption; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, line 3, after the word "title" and before the period insert the language to read
" , provided, however, that penalties contained for violation of any ordinance enacted pursuant to the provisions of this subparagraph shall not exceed the penalties established in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act"

and amend the title to conform

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 11, strike the words "Nothing contained in" and insert the language "Except as hereinafter provided," and after the word "shall" and before the word "prohibit" insert the word "not"

and on page 2, line 15, after the language "Statutes." insert the language

"Provided, however, no municipal ordinance relating to transporting a firearm improperly may include a provision for confiscation of property."

and amend the title to conform
