AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the stricken title, enacting
clause and entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to the Legislative Service Bureau;
limiting salary of the Executive Director of the
Criminal Justice Resource Center; making
appropriations nonfiscal; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The salary of the Director of the Oklahoma Criminal
Justice Resource Center shall be set by the Oklahoma Sentencing
Commission and shall not exceed Sixty-seven Thousand Five Hundred
Dollars (\$67,500.00) per annum, payable monthly for the months of
July, August, September, October, November and December, 2004.
Effective January 1, 2005, the salary of the Director shall not
exceed Sixty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$68,900.000) per
annum payable monthly for the remainder of the fiscal year ending
June 30, 2005.

SECTION 2. The appropriations made by Sections 49 and 50 of
Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma
Legislature shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and

shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004."
