An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 2-105, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 461, O.S.L. 2003, Section 4, Chapter 461, O.S.L. 2003 and 47 O.S. 2001, Section 2-117, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 404, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2003, Sections 2-105, 2-105A and 2-117), which relate to creation, organization, and responsibilities of the Department of Public Safety; * * * * providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 25, line 9 1/2, add a new subparagraph b to read

"b. the vehicle needs to travel on a public street or highway in order to cross a railroad track. In that event, the all-terrain vehicle may travel for not more than three hundred (300) feet on a public street or highway to cross a railroad track,"

and reletter subsequent subparagraphs

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 25, line 15, after the word "vehicles" and before the word "may" delete all language

and amend title to conform
