COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to insurance; requiring notice of nonrenewal or cancellation of insurance policy; providing requirements for mailing of notice; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3639.3 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Unless otherwise provided, insurers shall give at least ten (10) days' notice prior to the date of cancellation and twenty (20) days' notice prior to the date of nonrenewal of a homeowners insurance policy.

B. If notice is given by mail, said notice shall be deemed to have been given on the day said notice is mailed. Proof of mailing of the notice of cancellation or nonrenewal to the named insured at the address shown in the policy shall be sufficient proof of notice.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
