COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to corporation commission; requiring the Oklahoma Corporation Commission to promulgate certain rules providing certain exemption for certain religious persons; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.700 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules that provide for the exemption of individuals employed as preachers, ministers, priests, rabbis, or other ecclesiastical dignitaries whose church, synagogue, or building of public worship is located in a city or town with a population of one thousand (1,000) or less according to the latest Federal Decennial Census from commercial charges associated with a telecommunications service provider.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
