COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to waters and water rights;
designating certain section of the North Canadian
River as the Official Oklahoma River; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1D of Title 82, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A seven-mile section of the North Canadian River, between
Meridian Avenue and Eastern Avenue in Oklahoma City, shall be
designated as the Official Oklahoma River for economic development
purposes. The Oklahoma Centennial Commission shall cause suitable
markers to be placed along the seven-mile section of the river
identifying the river as "the Official Oklahoma River".

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
