COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-137, which relates to controlled hunts application fee; providing an exception to the fee for certain persons; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-137, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-137. A. In addition to any other fees authorized by law, the Department of Wildlife Conservation is authorized to impose a processing fee of not more than Five Dollars (\$5.00), per calendar year, per person, for controlled hunts applications pursuant to the O.A.C. 800:25-9-3.

B. Any person receiving Social Security Disability benefits, Supplemental Security Income benefits or disability benefits under the Railroad Retirement Act, 45 U.S.C.A., Section 231a, shall not be subject to the fee authorized by subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2005.
