(Public health and safety - multistate purchasing
groups -
emergency)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided by state or federal law, any state
agency having the power and responsibility of providing
pharmaceuticals to clients of the agency shall purchase such
pharmaceuticals through a multistate or multigovernmental contract
subject to the provisions of the State Purchasing Act if the terms
of the multistate or multigovernmental contract are more favorable
to the state or agency than the terms of an individual state
contract for the same pharmaceuticals as determined by the State
Purchasing Director.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
