CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; creating the Healthy and Fit Kids Act of 2004; providing short title; providing for establishment of Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committees; providing for membership; allowing combining of Advisory Committee with specified committee; providing for duties; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.1a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Healthy and Fit Kids Act of 2004".

B. Beginning September 1, 2004, each public school shall establish a Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee, to be composed of at least six members. The Advisory Committee may be composed of teachers, administrators, parents of students, health care professionals and business community representatives.

A public school may combine the Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee with its Safe School Committee, established pursuant to Section 24-100.5 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

C. Each Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee shall study and make recommendations to the school principal regarding:

1. Health education;
2. Physical education and physical activity; and
3. Nutrition and health services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2004.
