CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; making appropriations to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; stating purposes; authorizing expenditures of certain funds; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; requiring certain budgeting procedures; prohibiting certain budgeting procedures; providing lapse dates; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Six Hundred Eighty-eight Million Eight Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-three Dollars (\$688,855,923.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operation budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution which relate to a decrease in the General Revenue Fund, there is hereby appropriated

to the State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Twenty-one Million One Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$21,199,498.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operation budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 3. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, from the Oklahoma Student Aid Revolving Fund, the sum of Twenty-six Million Two Hundred Ninety-two Thousand One Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$26,292,114.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operation budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 4. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, from the Higher Education Capital Revolving Fund, the sum of Twenty-six Million Two Hundred Ninety-two Thousand One Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$26,292,114.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operation budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund A in the State Treasury, the sum of Eleven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-four Dollars (\$11,484.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund B in the State Treasury, the sum of Thirty Thousand One Hundred Eighty-two Dollars (\$30,182.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Five Million One Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Eighty-eight Dollars (\$5,199,088.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the general operating budget of the Administrative Offices of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 (hereafter FY-04) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 (hereafter FY-05). Funds budgeted for FY-04 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2004, and must be expended by November 15, 2004. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2004, and not budgeted for FY-05, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-05 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2005. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2005, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-04, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-05, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-04 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
