CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the University Hospitals Authority; making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS AUTHORITY

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Thirty-four Million Five Hundred Ninety-eight Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-five Dollars (\$34,598,585.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the University Hospitals Authority by law.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the University Hospitals Authority. The University Hospitals Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations, except as may be authorized

pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

Full-time-equivalent Employees	10.0

SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 (hereafter FY-04), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 (hereafter FY-05). Funds budgeted for FY-04 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2004, and must be expended by November 15, 2004. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2004, and not budgeted for FY-05, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-05 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2005. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2005, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-04, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-05, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-04 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
