CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 141.16, which relates to the Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act; authorizing assessment of fee when pressure retaining item is not prepared for inspection; clarifying application of fee; establishing fee for authorized inspector services; modifying the disposition of specified fees by transferring from General Revenue Fund to Department of Labor Revolving Fund; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 141.16, is amended to read as follows:

Section 141.16 A. Schedule of Fees

1. Annual certificate of operation fee

Note: Only one certificate of operation fee per year may be charged; except an additional fee equal to the certificate of operation fee may be charged for witnessing a hydrostatic test required after repairs and a fee equal to the certificate of operation fee may be charged when the pressure retaining item is not

prepared and ready, pursuant to rules promulgated by the Commissioner of Labor, at the time of a scheduled inspection.

B. Exemptions. All institutions owned or operated by the State of Oklahoma or its agencies or by any county, municipality or school district, and such institutions or agencies, and all owners or users of boilers or pressure vessels of historical significance as specified in subsection D of Section 141.5 of this title are exempt from the payment of any fees provided for herein.

C. Disposition of fees. The Commissioner of Labor shall account for and transfer all fees, except for shop review fees, Boiler Operator License fees, and Authorized Inspector Service fees so received to the State Treasury to the credit of the General Revenue Fund together with a detailed report of same. Shop review fees, Boiler Operator License fees (141.16(A)(2)(b)), Boiler Operator License fees (141.16(A)(2)(c)(3)), and Authorized Inspector

Services fees (141.16(A) (2) (g)) shall be deposited to the Department of Labor Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 141.19 of this title. The shop review fees, Boiler Operator License fees, and Authorized Inspector Services fees shall be used for conducting shop reviews, Authorized Inspector Services and for administrative costs pertaining to shop reviews, Boiler Operator Licensing and Authorized Inspector Services.

D. All fees shall be paid directly to the Department of Labor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
