BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-147 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Education shall require that all schools
in which vending machines are accessible to students in elementary
and middle schools ensure that beverages and snacks with no or low
nutritional value, as defined in the United States Department of
Agriculture (USDA) guidelines, be replaced with beverages and snacks
that meet the nutrition standards established in the USDA guidelines
for the federal lunch program. Each school may establish stricter
guidelines as recommended by its Safe and Healthy Schools Advisory
Committee.

B. The State Board of Education shall require that all schools
in which vending machines are accessible to students in high schools
establish incentive pricing that offers healthy beverage and snack
options that meet the nutrition standards established in the USDA
guidelines for the federal lunch program at prices that are less
than the prices of beverages and snacks that have no or low
nutritional value, as defined in the USDA guidelines. Each school

may establish stricter guidelines as recommended by its Safe and Healthy Schools Advisory Committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.
