COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to definitions and general provisions; creating the Senator Keith Leftwich Day; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.15 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The first Tuesday in February in a presidential election year is hereby designated as "Senator Keith Leftwich Day" to commemorate the Senator who was the principal author of the legislation that moved the presidential primary to the first Tuesday in February and made the State of Oklahoma a player on the national political stage.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
