BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.27C.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Whenever a reduction-in-force occurs within the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department pursuant to Section 840-2.27C of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the appointing authority shall not consider any employee for dismissal until all employees in positions within the department who were employed within the last three (3) years have been dismissed as a result of the aforementioned reduction-in-force.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
