[county government and the environment - county powers to abate nuisances - requiring the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to complete annual audit of the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Account -

emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2001, Section 20, is amended to read as follows:

Section 20. The board of county commissioners of any county in this state ~~with a population in excess of five hundred fifty thousand (550,000)~~ may declare what shall constitute a nuisance, and provide for the prevention, removal and abatement of nuisances for those properties acquired by the county through resale and any property located within an unincorporated area of the county.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2001, Section 1085.60, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2002 (82 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 1085.60), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1085.60 ~~The Office of the State Auditor and Inspector~~ Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall ~~perform~~ cause to be completed an annual audit of ~~any expenditures from~~ the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Account.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
