

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
amending Section 5, Chapter 408, O.S.L. 2002 (59 O.S.
Supp. 2002, Section 353.30), which relates to the
Board of Pharmacy; prohibiting certain injections by
pharmacists; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 408, O.S.L.
2002 (59 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 353.30), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 353.30 A. The use of agreements in the practice of
pharmacy shall be acceptable within the rules ~~established~~
promulgated by the Board of Pharmacy and in consultation with the
State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board
of Osteopathic Examiners.

B. The Board of Pharmacy shall develop and prepare permanent
rules relating to training requirements and administration of
immunizations in consultation within the State Board of Medical
Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic
Examiners.

C. A pharmacist who has completed a requisite course of
training as approved by the Board of Pharmacy in consultation with
the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State
Board of Osteopathic Examiners, may administer immunizations only on
patient specific orders from osteopathic physicians or allopathic
physicians.

D. Except as provided by this section, a pharmacist is not authorized to administer any therapeutic or other injection in the practice of pharmacy.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
