WHEREAS, the units of the Oklahoma National Guard and the 45th Infantry Division served with distinction in World War II, the Korean Conflict, Desert Shield/Desert Storm, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom; and

WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma National Guard and the 45th Infantry Division are deserving of proper recognition for their

honorable service in defending our great nation and state against grave perils; and

WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma National Guard and the 45th Infantry Division who made ultimate sacrifices for freedom, democracy, and the pursuit of happiness deserve to be remembered and honored on a special day; and

WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma National Guard and the 45th Infantry Division exhibited tremendous courage, bravery, and sacrifice in battles that included those in Italy at the landings on Sicily, near Salerno and at Anzio and the subsequent conflicts; the landing in southern France and combat on to Nuremberg and Munich, Germany; and the combat in the Korean Conflict, including engagements on Old Baldy, the T-Bone, and Heartbreak Ridge.
