A Concurrent Resolution commending and congratulating the Oklahoma State University Cowboys wrestling team for achieving the rank of national champions; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Cowboys have emerged victorious as the 2004 Big 12 Tournament champions in men=s wrestling and went on to take the title of national champions for the second year in a row; and

WHEREAS, the Cowboys wrestling team captured its second consecutive Big 12 Tournament title, amassing 86.5 points, and scored a total of 123.5 points at the NCAA championships, 41.5 points ahead of the second place team; and

WHEREAS, the Pokes were consistently ranked Number One nationally throughout the year, making them a favorite to repeat as national champions; and

WHEREAS, the Cowboys wrestling team performed beyond expectations under the expert guidance of former Olympic champion and four-time national champion and Big 12 Wrestling Coach of the Year Coach John Smith, three-time national champion Assistant Coach Eric Guerrero, and two-time national champion Associate Head Coach Mark Branch; and
