

ENGROSSED SENATE
CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION NO. 17

A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Department of Corrections to dispose of unnecessary or burdensome assets; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections individually, and through the Office of Public Affairs, formerly the State Board of Public Affairs (now the Department of Central Services), has accepted gifts from individuals and corporations; and

WHEREAS, some of the property previously accepted is no longer needed by the Department of Central Services or the Department of Corrections and the ownership of the donated property has become a burden on the State of Oklahoma and the Department of Corrections; and

WHEREAS, it would be a benefit to the State of Oklahoma and the Department of Corrections to transfer this property either to another agency or back to the original donor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature authorizes the Department of Corrections acting through the Department of Central Services to transfer by bill of sale, contract, deed or other indicia of ownership, property, which it has received from individuals or corporations, for which it has no use or which has become burdensome to the Department of Corrections or the Department of Central Services, to any other state agency which can utilize the property or if there is none, back to the original donor.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature authorizes the Department of Corrections acting through the Department of Central Services to grant any necessary easements to public utilities which are necessary for the transfer or for the benefit of the State of Oklahoma.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature directs that consideration for such transfer shall be determined by the Director of the Department of Corrections in consultation with the Director of the Department of Central Services.

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature finds that if the property be deemed burdensome to the Department of Corrections, relief from the liability of ownership shall be sufficient consideration for the transfer.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Director of the Department of Corrections and the Director of the Department of Central Services.
