RESOLUTION NO. 50

A Joint Resolution designating the month of May of each year as "Motorcycle Safety Month" in the State of Oklahoma; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, motorcycles are an important means of transportation and a source of recreation; and

WHEREAS, motorcycles have been used in local and national government activities in peacetime and wartime; and

WHEREAS, it is important for motorcyclists to develop sound riding skills and safety habits; and

WHEREAS, all motorist should be aware of their obligation to responsibly and safely share the roads and streets with motorcyclists; and

WHEREAS, due to the increased number of motorcycles on the road, it is appropriate to set aside a time to promote motorcycle safety awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.15 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The month of May of each year is hereby designated as "Motorcycle Safety Month" in the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
