An Act relating to the Oklahoma Personnel Act; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-2.29, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 292, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 840-2.29), which relates to on-call classified employees; clarifying minimum compensation for classified employees in an on-call status; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-2.29, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 292, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 840-2.29), is amended to read as follows:

Section 840-2.29 A classified employee who is on-call shall receive be compensated for a minimum of two (2) hours of work if the employee reports to a work location while in an on-call status. This provision shall apply anytime the employee reports and works less than two (2) hours.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
