An Act relating to the Legislative Service Bureau; making appropriations; stating purposes; limiting salary of the Executive Director of the Criminal Justice Resource Center; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of One Million Four Hundred Sixty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-four Dollars (\$1,466,864.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of Five Hundred Ninety-four Thousand One Hundred Four Dollars (\$594,104.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center by law.

SECTION 3. The salary of the Director of the Criminal Justice Resource Center shall be set by the Oklahoma Sentencing Commission and shall not exceed Sixty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$67,500.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
