An Act relating to the Oklahoma Military Department;
authorizing the transfer of certain real property;
stating use of property; providing for reversion of
property under certain conditions; providing for
noncodification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Legislature hereby authorizes the Oklahoma Military
Department to transfer to the City of Pryor, Oklahoma, certain
property, including any encumbrances thereon, situated in Mayes
County, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as:

A tract of land situated in the Southeast Quarter of the
Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 21 North, Range 19 East of
the Indian Base and Meridian, Mayes County, Oklahoma, and more fully
described as follows: commencing at the Southeast corner of said
Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, thence S 89E28'55" W
along the South line thereof, 1195.70 feet, thence N 0E07'36" E,
40.00 feet to the North right-of-way line of Southeast Ninth Street
and the point beginning; thence N 0E07'36" E, 999.81 feet; thence S
89E37'10" E, 665.23 feet; thence S 0E07'36" W, 1004.62 feet; to the
North line of the county road right-of-way; thence S 89E28'55" W
along said right-of-way line, 129.65 feet; thence N 1E35'32" W,
15.25 feet; thence N 89E28'55" E, 14.00 feet; thence N 0E30'58" W,
100.00 feet; thence S 89E28'55" W, 100.00 feet; thence S 0E30'58" E,
100 feet to the North right-of-way line of Southeast Ninth Street;
thence S 89E28'55" W, along said right-of-way line, 449.15 feet to
the point of beginning. Containing 15.00 acres and subject to
easements of record.

The described property will be used by the City of Pryor for a
community recreational center. In the event the City of Pryor does
not construct a community recreational center within seven (7) years
or the city discontinues use of the property for said purpose, the
property is to revert back to the Oklahoma Military Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
