An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
Commerce; amending Section 10, Chapter 446, O.S.L.
2003, which relates to budget categories; changing
category amounts; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 446, O.S.L.
2003, is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the
Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall budget all funds in the
following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
