An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Senate; making an appropriation; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Senate by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act and by Section 56 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2007 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.
