An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 2001, Section 8-110, which relates to city officials; and modifying requirements for city officials to become candidates for county or state office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 8-110, is amended to read as follows:

Section 8-110. Any member of a ~~city~~ municipal governing body, the city or town clerk, and the city marshal, ~~may not, unless he resigns from the office held by him,~~ shall be eligible to become a candidate for a county or state office without resigning from the office held by the officer. ~~This provision shall not apply to any municipality governed by charter, nor to incorporated towns.~~
