An Act relating to the Court of Criminal Appeals;  
amending Section 2, Chapter 311, O.S.L. 2003, which  
relates to budget categories; changing category  
amounts; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 311, O.S.L.  
2003, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the Court  
of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
Court Operations	\$2,634,378.00	<del>\$2,667,378.00</del> <u>\$2,699,569.00</u>

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
