An Act relating to officers; amending 51 O.S. 2001, Section 36.2A, which relates to loyalty oath or affirmation; updating reference; repealing 51 O.S. 2001, Sections 2 and 36.2, which relate to loyalty oath or affirmation; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2001, Section 36.2A, is amended to read as follows:

Section 36.2A The oath or affirmation required by this act, same being cumulative to the oath of office required by ~~51 O.S. 1961, Section 2~~ Section 1 of Article XV of the Oklahoma Constitution, shall be as follows:

I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America and the Constitution and the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and that I will faithfully discharge, according to the best of my ability, the duties of my office or employment during such time as I am _____

(Here put name of office, or, if an employee, insert "An Employee Of _____" followed by the complete designation of the employing officer, agency, authority, commission, department or institution.)

SECTION 2. REPEALER 51 O.S. 2001, Sections 2 and 36.2, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
