An Act relating to state government; requiring state agencies to provide a response when denying certain applications; specifying certain items to be included in the response; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3118 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every state agency that has authority to deny a permit, license, or tax exemption shall provide a written response to the applicant at the time of denial that states the reason for the denial, any applicable appeals procedure for the applicant, and any time limitation for filing an appeal.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
