BILL NO. 1523

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Welcome Center located at Sallisaw, Oklahoma, as the "Hoppy Lockhart Welcome Center"; directing the Department of Transportation to place permanent suitable markings at the facility bearing the name; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1658 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Welcome Center located at Sallisaw, Oklahoma, near mile marker 314, shall be designated as the "Hoppy Lockhart Welcome Center". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed at the facility bearing the name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
