**An Act** relating to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System; making an appropriation thereto; stating purpose; redesignating use of certain funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the State Judicial Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay conflict counsel contracts.

SECTION 2. REDESIGNATION The amount of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000.00) appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, by Section 14, Chapter 432, O.S.L. 2001, for the purpose of forensic testing of evidence in relation to the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System, is hereby redesignated to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law. If on the date this act is approved any of the amount originally appropriated as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less than the redesignated amount, that redesignated amount is reduced to the unencumbered balance.

SECTION 3. REDESIGNATION The amount of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000.00) appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, by Section 3, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2002, for the purpose of forensic testing of evidence in relation to the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System, is hereby redesignated to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law. If on the date this act is approved any of the amount originally appropriated as adjusted by expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered balance less than the redesignated amount, that redesignated amount is reduced to the unencumbered balance.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
