An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7305-1.1, which relates to juvenile bureaus; modifying counties in which juvenile bureaus and citizens' advisory committees are created; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7305-1.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7305-1.1 A. In each county having a population of ~~one hundred thousand (100,000)~~ eighty thousand (80,000) or more, as shown by the last preceding Federal Decennial Census, there is created a juvenile bureau and a citizens' advisory committee.

B. In each county having a duly constituted juvenile bureau as of January 1, ~~1981~~ 2005, as provided for in subsection A of this section, the juvenile bureau shall remain in place and continue in operation. No other counties shall establish juvenile bureaus.

C. The Department of Juvenile Justice shall provide intake, probation and parole services in all counties not having juvenile bureaus as provided for in Section 7302-2.3 of this title.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
