An Act relating to the roads, bridges and ferries;
designating the "Keith Leftwich Memorial Loop";
directing the Department of Transportation to place
suitable permanent markers on the highway bearing his
name; designating the "Helen Cole Memorial Highway";
directing the Department of Transportation to place
suitable permanent markers on the highway bearing her
name; providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1655 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Interstate Highway 240 between Interstate 35 and Interstate 44
in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Keith
Leftwich Memorial Loop". The Department of Transportation shall
cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
his name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1653 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Interstate 35 between Interstate 240 and Indian Hills Road shall be designated as the "Helen Cole Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing her name.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
