An Act relating to the Office of Handicapped  
Concerns; amending Section 2, Chapter 250, O.S.L.  
2003, which relates to budget limits for the Office  
of Handicapped Concerns; modifying budget limits; and  
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OFFICE OF HANDICAPPED CONCERNS

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 250, O.S.L.  
2003, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the Office  
of Handicapped Concerns shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

General Operations	\$356,000.00	<del>\$356,000.00</del> <u>\$360,242.00</u>
Client Assistance Program	<u>0.00</u>	<u>125,000.00</u>
TOTAL	\$356,000.00	<del>\$481,000.00</del> <u>\$485,242.00</u>

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
each budget category.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
