A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the Commission for Human Services to enter into certain lease-purchase agreements for certain office space; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the board of county commissioners in each county in the State of Oklahoma to furnish quarters for the local units of the Department of Human Services, unless it is determined that adequate or suitable quarters from the county are not available or obtainable; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Boards of County Commissioners of Garfield and Garvin Counties, Oklahoma, do not have adequate resources to meet this legal obligation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services has determined that it is desirable to enter into projects to construct, acquire, and/or renovate adequate or suitable facilities to serve as group homes for persons with developmental disabilities in Garfield and Garvin Counties and to lease-purchase these facilities; and

WHEREAS, the lease-purchase agreements will provide that, upon conclusion of the lease-purchase term, the title will transfer to the Department of Human Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 189a of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes requires that this type of transaction receive legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT in order to offer accessible and comprehensive services to clients of the Department of Human Services in Garfield and Garvin Counties, the Commission for Human Services, subject to the availability of funds, is hereby authorized to enter into lease-purchase agreements to construct, acquire and/or renovate adequate or suitable facilities to serve as group homes for persons with developmental disabilities in Garfield and Garvin Counties.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Commission for Human Services.
