WHEREAS, the Shattuck High School Indians football team has long been a power in Western Oklahoma. The Indians were undefeated and won their division title in 1991 and in the 2002 season lost only one out of 13 games; and

WHEREAS, the Shattuck High School Indians football team was undefeated during the 2003 season, outscoring its four playoff opponents 196-18 and winning each of its 13 games in 2003 by an average of 31 points; and

WHEREAS, the Shattuck High School Indians football team gained nearly 500 yards in offense to win the Class C1 State Championship on the afternoon of Saturday, December 6, 2003, in front of almost 1,500 fans in Kalsu Stadium at Del City High School in Del City, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, three Shattuck Indians were named to the Eight-Man All-Stars and will play in the All-Star football game this summer, and seven Indians were named as Academic All-District.
