A Resolution praising Oklahoma City Firefighters  
Local 157 for adopting two Oklahoma City public pools  
that would have been closed for the summer as a  
result of budget cuts; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, when it appeared that 24 Oklahoma City public pools  
would be closed for the summer due to budget cuts, Oklahoma City  
Firefighters Local 157 came to the rescue by adopting two of the  
public junior pools. The Executive Board of the local union voted  
unanimously to adopt two of the pools; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma City Firefighters Local 157 will pay  
\$5,000 per pool to cover the cost of providing lifeguards. Other  
costs will be paid by the City of Oklahoma City. The pools adopted  
by the city's firefighters are the E.B. Jeffrey Pool adjacent to  
Fire Station 24 in Ward 3 and the McCracken Pool adjacent to Fire  
Station 16 in Ward 4. These two pools were recommended for adoption  
by the Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, Local 157 President Michael Anderson, who is also a  
member of the State Fire Marshal Commission, said "We are delighted  
to be able to do something that makes the summer months so much more  
fun for children." The pools will be open to the public between  
June 3 and August 1, 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate praises Oklahoma City  
Firefighters Local 157 for adopting and keeping open two public  
junior pools that would have been closed for the summer as a result  
of budget cuts.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Michael L. Anderson, President of the Oklahoma City Firefighters Local 157.
