WHEREAS, Rick Littlefield is completing his twelfth year of service to the citizens of District 1 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Rick Littlefield was born in Vinita, Oklahoma, on July 27, 1952, to Jarvis and JoAnn (Bilbo) Littlefield. He is married to Alicia (Gibbes) and is the father of Creed Steen. He attended Northeastern Oklahoma A&M College, and the Oklahoma Police Academy and is a small business owner; and

WHEREAS, Rick Littlefield has served in the Oklahoma State Senate since 1993, having previously served in the House of Representatives, and currently serves as chair of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Natural Resources and Regulatory Services. In this position he has worked tirelessly to increase Oklahoma tourism, improve the quality of our land, air and water, and enhance the image of our state beyond its borders; and

WHEREAS, State Question No. 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for members of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result thereof, Senator Rick Littlefield will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Rick Littlefield's diligent efforts and attention to detail have made him a recognized expert in state fiscal policy relating to tourism, state regulation, the environment and natural resources, and these qualities will be missed as much as his cheerful smile and his ready handshake.
