RESOLUTION NO. 84

A Resolution commending the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce upon their centennial; designating June 3, 2004, "Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce Centennial Day" in the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, on June 3, 1904, the modern day Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce began as the Bartlesville Commercial Club. Many of the founding fathers and businessmen of the day recognized the need for an organization that would take charge of overseeing public welfare and would bear the weighty burden of furthering the prosperity of Bartlesville; and

WHEREAS, since 1904 the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce has been actively involved with economic and community development and improvement to the business climate and quality of life for all Bartlesville area citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce was the first chamber to pass a resolution endorsing statehood for Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce is looking forward to another century serving as the gatekeeper for the business community in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates and commends the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce for 100 years of service to their community and the State of Oklahoma.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate designates Thursday, June 3, 2004, "Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce Centennial Day" in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Government Relations Committee of the Bartlesville Area Chamber of Commerce.
